It's not too late to participate in the Berkshire Conference Book Exhibit to be held June 12-15, 2008 at the University of Minnesota in Minneapolis! The registration deadline has been extended until October 10. The book exhibit will be located in Willey Hall, which is prominently placed adjacent to session meetings, all of which will be taking place on the compact West Bank campus. Conference registration will also be located in Willey Hall. The space is air conditioned, has wi-fi capabilities and can be fully secured after hours.

Attached please find reservation materials including prices, options and amenities. I'm pleased to report that we have maintained our prices from the last Berkshire Conference—that's no price increase since 1999! Included in your exhibit fee are pipe and drape, two skirted tables, two folding chairs, a wastebasket, a sign and two passes to the conference. Additionally, we will provide student assistants to vendors during the exhibit so that you might take a break.

Once you have sent us your reservation, the exhibit company, Hubbell/Tyner, will contact you with information on renting additional furnishings or larger signage for your booth, as well as on storage and delivery of your exhibit materials. The cost will be \$144 per 200 lbs of material, with a 200 lb minimum. This procedure is different from the way the Berks book exhibit has operated in the past, but is typical of other large academic conferences. If you have questions about this, please contact me.
